One of the prerequisites to participate in this program is having completed **6 credit hours** in Spanish at SMU in the year prior to departure (SPAN 1000 or SPAN 2204 -2205).

Have a **letter of permission** signed by the Spanish Study Abroad Coordinator and your school dean's office
